Regular undergraduate (3rd, 4th year) and master program students with good communication ability in English.

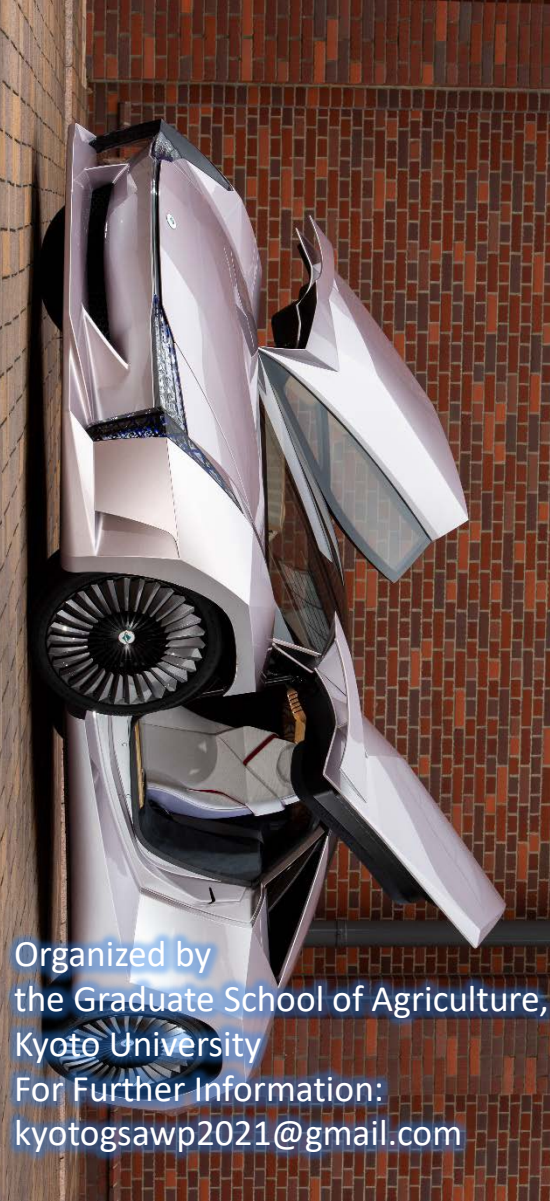
