Greetings from the Faculty of Agriculture and Animal Science (FAAS) of the University of Muhammadiyah Malang (UMM), Indonesia. In 2024, the FAAS, UMM will organize a Summer Course in the Faculty of Agriculture and Animal Science (SCFAAS, the student exchange program) from October 16th to 24th.

The student exchange program "SCFAAS 2024" is a special opportunity for international students to gain new knowledge and learn Indonesian customs and culture. This will benefit participating students and help them have a better professional life. The student exchange program is not just about study. Still, it will also help students build integrative learning skills, multicultural competencies, practical knowledge, self-confidence, and lifelong friendships with people in different countries. This exchange program is eligible for both undergraduate students and graduate students. Students from partner universities/institutes can transfer the academic credit based on the consent of their home universities. Please be informed that registration and accommodation fees collected by the University will be waived for quota students, and all necessary materials will be provided. I offer three (3) students from each department in UMM to receive this quota. Quota each department based on the speed of responding to this offer letter.

Our Departments are Agrotechnology, Agribusiness, Food Technology, Forestry, Animal Science, and Aquaculture. If more students are interested in this program, the extra students will have to pay 250 USD each.

Required Documents

- 2. A copy of the passport
- 3. A copy of your current student ID or a certificate of student status

Expenses

- Participants must purchase airline tickets to and from Surabaya and a ticket to Malang. FAAS-UMM will
 cover all other expenses, including accommodation, lunches, dinners, breakfasts, and local
 transportation for all participants in Malang.
- Participants are required to obtain an appropriate entry visa from the Indonesian Embassy before entering Indonesia, except for countries entitled to visa exemption and visa on arrival.
- Participants are advised to secure travel insurance that covers emergency services and sickness during their stay in Thailand.
