In Amiens, Beauvais, Rennes and Rouen, UniLaSalle, a higher education and research establishment, offers 5-year post-baccalaureate engineering courses, a 6-year post-baccalaureate veterinary course (starting next September), bachelors and masters degrees in the fields of agriculture, agri-food, foodhealth, environment, geosciences, energy and digital technology.

UniLaSalle is a member of the Conférence des Grandes Écoles and its engineering courses are accredited by the CTI (Commission des Titres d'Ingénieur). UniLaSalle is part of the La Salle global education network made up of 72 universities and is supported by 260 partner universities abroad. The Institute currently has 4,000 students, supported by 520 employees, including 180 teacher-researchers, 40 PhD students and 22,000 alumni.

Inaugurated in 2008, the campus is located in Mont-Saint-Aignan, 15 minutes by bus from the historic centre of Rouen. Formerly known as ESITPA, the campus took the name UniLaSalle in January 2016. It is now home to courses dedicated to new forms of agriculture, non-food development of agricultural resources and the newly created Veterinary School.

Job description

Teaching

Teach and coordinate courses at Bachelor and Master level in political and management sciences. The candidate's exact disciplinary field may be political sciences, social economy or entrepreneurship. There are teaching and academic management needs in these different disciplinary fields. This is why the exact missions of the position will be adapted to the academic profile of the recruited candidate.

Research

Design, conduct and develop research projects to generate knowledge and explore new fronts of science in the fields of Interact research unit (UP 2018.C102). The research unit's work aims to better understand the processes of innovation towards sustainable development of agriculture, agri-food and agro-industry and their conditions for success.

It is to analyze, in an interdisciplinary perspective associating human and social sciences, life, earth and environmental sciences and engineering sciences, the innovation processes at work in these sectors at a time of fundamental changes they are going through.

Among the themes developed:

- sociotechnical transition to sustainable agriculture, managerial innovations in collective CSR initiatives,
- organization of the supply in the framework of the new supply chains, in particular for the complete valorization of the biomass of the new generation biorefineries,
- governance of multi-stakeholder innovation processes in competitiveness clusters.

The unit thus aims to produce reading and analysis grids useful to public and private decision-makers in their strategic thinking.
