The maximum score for each item may not exceed the assigned weight indicated on the scoring sheet.</u> 3. The score for the “External publication review” field shall be the weighted average score of the external publication review. <u>Members</u> of the College Faculty Evaluation Committee do <u>not</u> need to assign a score. 4. The threshold for a passing score is 70. 5. A candidate is considered to have passed the review if they receive a passing score from at least two thirds of the members of the College Faculty Evaluation Committee. 6.
